Workshop Goals for Participants

Application Process: Eligibility

- Pre-dissertation proposal doctoral students
- Studying topics related to poverty or inequality in the US
- Attending a US university other than UW-Madison
- Be from an economically disadvantaged background



Application Process: Application

- Complete <u>online Application Form</u>
- Have your dissertation advisor complete the <u>online Recommendation Form</u>
- Deadline is January 30, 2026



Application Process: Timeline

- January 30, 2026: Application Deadline
- Early March 2026: Notification of acceptance
- May 18-22, 2026: Workshop dates



Awards

- Week-long workshop
- Funding for travel, meals, and lodging at Howard University
- Chance to apply for a \$4,950 student research award
